Church services at St. Paul's will start again on June 14. There will be two services at 8:30AM and 10:00AM with communion offered at both. Videos of the service will still be available online for those who are reluctant to return to in-person services.

Changes are being made to minimize the risk of spreading the virus

No Sunday school will be held for now

Communion will be offered once a month on the 2nd Sunday

Please use the south carport door to enter the church. An usher or greeter will open the door to minimize contact.

Wearing a mask is highly recommended

Please minimize gathering in groups in the narthex area

The collection plate will not be passed. An offering plate will be located in the narthex

The Guide and printed order of service will be available for pickup when entering the church

Pews will be taped off or blocked in every other row to keep distance

There will be no member scripture readers for now

Greeters are still welcome to greet at a distance with no handshakes

Communion distribution will be moved from the altar rail to the area in front of the pews to avoid the need to touch any railings

No need to register for communion. The Elders will track communion attendance.

Private communions in the social hall will be held once a month and will be a good opportunity for those who are concerned

about being in a group to have the opportunity to take communion. Social hall communion this month is June 10 from 1:00 -4:00 PM.

An opening hymn and sermon hymn will be the only two hymns sung for now

At the end of the service dismissal will start from the back pews to help keep members distanced apart

If you feel sick, please stay home. For those who are at high risk and uncomfortable about being in a group you should not feel obligated to attend.

We look forward to gathering together again next Sunday.
